WHAT IT IS

A dedicated Search & Rescue application for nonprofits and tribal nations. Support Beacon Rescue™ extends the Support Beacon platform into volunteer field operations so teams can organize personnel, assign search areas, track field activity, and coordinate searches with the same secure, real-time visibility that Support Beacon Relief™ brings to disaster-relief logistics. Built to support Rancher Navy's volunteer Search and Rescue operations, other nonprofits, and tribal nations, and currently in testing within the SB217™ platform suite.

PLANNED CAPABILITIES

■ Deployment Organization

A search stands up as an operation of record: who was called, who responded, and what each team was given to do.

■ Assignment Management

Tasks issued to teams and tracked through to completion, so no segment is assumed covered because someone remembers calling it.

■ Mobile-First

Built for the device a volunteer already carries into the field, not for a laptop back at the command post.

■ Built on the SB217™ Suite

Shares a platform with Support Beacon Relief™ and the enterprise edition, Support Beacon Logistics™, rather than standing alone.

■ Team Location Tracking

Ground team positions visible to the coordinator running the search, so the next assignment reflects where crews actually are.

■ Real-Time Search Coordination

The same secure, real-time visibility Support Beacon Relief™ brings to disaster logistics, turned toward the search itself.

■ Secure Role-Based Access

Coordinators, team leads, and volunteers each see the view their role requires - and searches involving missing persons stay controlled.

■ Nonprofit & Tribal Availability

Fuzion intends to make Support Beacon Rescue™ available to nonprofit SAR organizations and tribal nations.

WHERE IT COMES FROM

It began on the Guadalupe, the Fourth of July, 2025.

Support Beacon Rescue™ was inspired by Rancher Navy's volunteer Search and Rescue team, whose members answered the call during the Guadalupe River flooding in the Texas Hill Country. It is being built for the way volunteer ground teams actually work, by people who were there - which is a different starting point than most software brings to this problem.
